

Grill Policy

Dear Guests,

To avoid possible accidents and injuries, please carefully read the following guidelines:

1. Proper Use:

- Use the grill only as intended, for preparing food that can be grilled, and in accordance with all provisions of this manual.
- Improper use or uses beyond those mentioned are not allowed. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Do not operate the grill with charcoal or other fuel; use only liquefied gas (propane/butane).
 - Do not use the grill for cooking in pots or pans.
 - Do not use the grill to heat or dry textiles or other materials. Only use it for heating grillable foods.

2. Safety Information for Gas Grills:

- During operation, some parts of the grill, especially near the fire bowl, become very hot. The possible consequences are:
 - Serious burns if you touch parts close to the fire bowl.
 - Fire or smoldering if combustible materials are near the grill.
- No combustible material should come near the grill. Maintain a minimum distance of 2 meters at the top and 1 meter at the sides from any combustible materials. Do not move the grill during operation.
- Wear grilling gloves.
- Never leave the grill unattended. Pay particular attention to keep children and pets away from the grill.
- Only use the grill outdoors in well-ventilated areas.
- Protect the gas cylinder and gas line from direct sunlight and other heat sources (maximum 50°C). Ensure the gas line does not touch hot grill parts.
- Do not place the gas cylinder in the lower stack as it would be too close to the burner tray.
- When lighting the gas flame, do not lean over the grilling surface.
- Close the valve of the gas cylinder immediately after each use.

3. General Instructions:

- Please follow the posted grill usage instructions. The grill can only be used at your own risk. Neither the manufacturer nor the accommodation operator assumes responsibility for any health or other issues that may arise.
